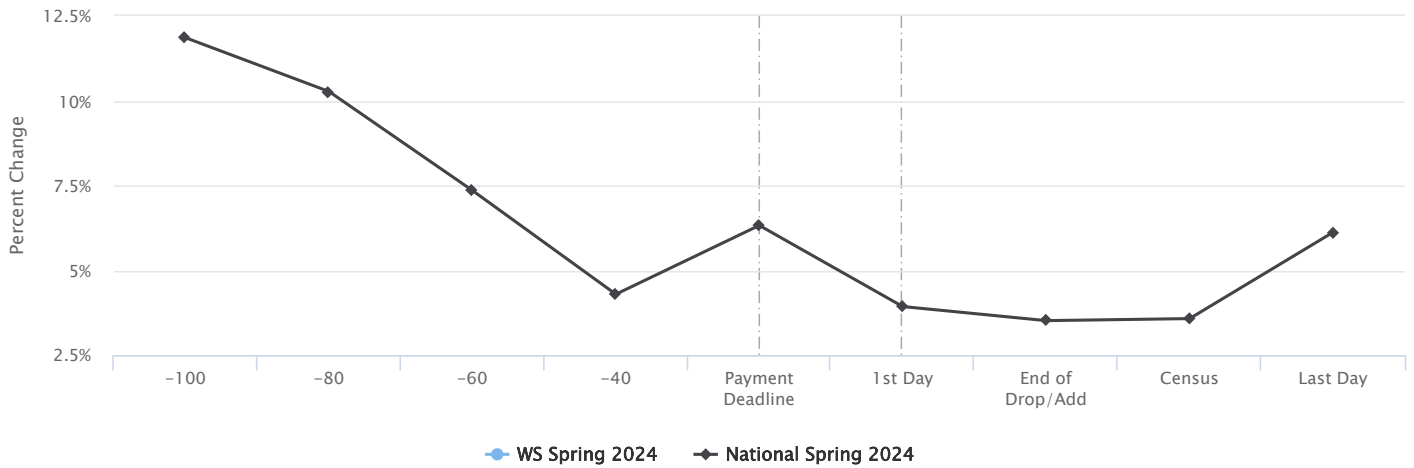


**Key National Benchmarks – Where Does Your Institution Stand?**

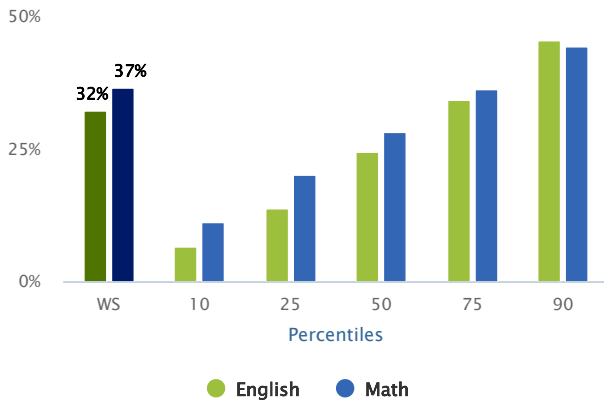

**Enrolled Student Credit Hours (SCH) by Days from Census – Percent Change**

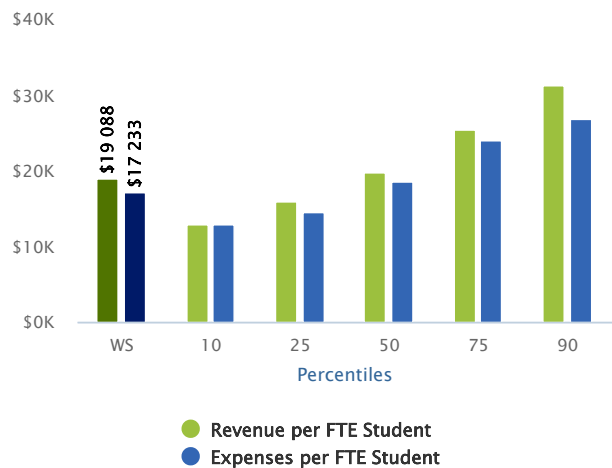


The percentage change of student credit hours between Spring 2023 enrollment compared to Spring 2024 enrollment over the period of 100 days prior to and throughout until the college's census day.

Completing Gateway Courses**



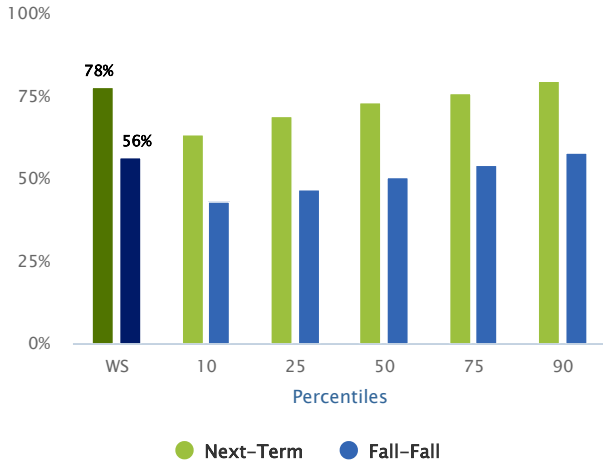
**Revenue and Expenses per FTE Student**



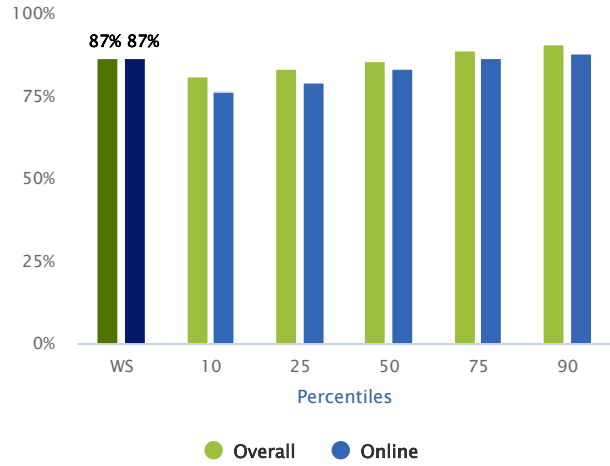
The percentage of first-time students from Fall 2022 completing gateway courses in English Comp I/II and Math by the end of Spring 2023 term.

## Completer Success Rate



The persistence rate is the percent of Fall 2022 credit students, both full- and part-time, who return to the campus for the next term (usually Spring 2023), or for the next Fall term (Fall 2023). This metric excludes students who graduated or completed certificates in the time frame.

The percent of students who received grades of A, B, C, or Pass in their courses in Fall 2022.
